for bringing in new, younger members. Mark said he enjoyed being chair, but just can't do it any more. Currently the group has \$4,043.

There was some discussion on incentives to members by working. **Judy Corbitt** clarified that the Region does do this, but members must work road races and Solo I events because working a Solo II event is part of the event.

**Mark** said that Speed Freakz gives someone five years to become really hooked. With First Gear there's only one or two years to get it ingrained in them. **Russ Smith** said that the same subject came up at the Central Florida Region annual meeting. **Wanda Cecil** suggested attending the Area 3 meeting and bring it up there at the business meeting. **Karen** said the cost is less or equal to a muffler for some cars. To her it appears that the SCCA is an older crowd and there needs to be more marketing to the younger crowd. **Judy** stated that we use the open house to promote the region. **John Ingram** said that they used to advertise on the radio, but then there were legal issues. **Mike King** asked if the Region has ever thought of lowering the requirement to two races instead of four.

### Treasurer's Report

The report was given to the Board members. It also included a statement on the investment account that is finally making money again. A new "Cash Transfer" account has been opened. **Kaye McCloy**

explained that it is a savings account that money can be transferred back and forth through and it earns a little interest in the process.

### Track Manager's Report

**Kaye** reported that in 2003 237 days were rented at the track. So far for 2004 172 days are booked. The South Carolina Region is trying a new program, so they have picked up nine days. **Fred Schmucker** asked if the cost of the bathrooms was in the financial report, it was. The bathrooms are finished and they purchased new radios with double batteries. **Richard McCloy** reported that they just purchased two new copiers, one for the track managers and one for the tower. **Mike Walters** asked if it was possible to have surge protectors to prevent equipment from getting struck by lightening. **Richard** said they had them. **Ted** asked about needing another laptop. He will get with David Williams and find out what is needed. We may need a second laptop to run the printer across the track.

**Fred S.** asked if we had an inventory list. **Ted** said that Ross & Ross has the list. **Fred S.** asked if everything was insured. **Bill Williams** suggested keeping a record of the acquisition date as well. **Fred S.** said the inventory list should be available to all Board members. **Fred C.** stated that the list has always been available. **Fred S.** suggested taking the Ross & Ross list and checking it against what we actually have.

**Fred C.** asked that all of the different groups bring an inventory list to the next meeting.

**Richard** said the fire marshal came to the track and checked things over. He was there 20 minutes and okayed everything. At the Solo I event Richard did a fire extinguisher check. 80% of the people did not have one. The 20% of those that did were wrong. **Ted** stated that the Region needs to communicate to the racers that they need to have these in their paddocks. **Fred C.** asked if the contracts had already been sent to people. **Kaye** said they have already been sent, but they can do an extra mailing to remind people about the fire extinguishers. **Mike** asked if there were any stipulations for big rigs. Only one fire bottle is needed per paddock area. **Fred C.** suggested having some for sale at the gas pumps. **Larry** asked if it would be possible to find out how Road Atlanta handles the extinguishers. **Kaye** said they handle it no different than Roebing. **Bill** stated that he is new, but to him the track managers do a great job.

### Membership Report

**Paula Frazier** reported that we started the year off with 575 members and we now have 530 members. **Ted** said we need to find out where those people went. National has a new online information that we can look at. **Karen** stated that we should find out who left and send them a survey and ask why they left.

### Race Chair Report

**Faye Craft** reported that she has already mailed out 46 packets for the drivers school. She needs a Paddock Marshal and workers for Friday. The school dates are 12-15 February. **Ted** would like to have the school information posted on the Website. **Faye** suggested sending Karen the same ad that was run in Grassroots Motorsports that has all of the information. **Fred C.** asked if the school has been limited to the number of entries. **Faye** said they are trying to keep it at three groups with only 50 people in each group. **Fred C.** suggested making it clear there is limited space.

### Competition Chair Report

**Fred C.** reported that there is a new form that can be used to help drivers with their log books for the first time. The sheet was used at Nationals and worked well. The September event went well, but the entries were low. He has been approached about having a DSR enduro at the September event in 2004. He was also approached by the racers who run in the HSR RS (IMSA) class to allow them to join the vintage event. The event will be held 11 September.

**Denise** asked if there was any feedback on the Solo I event. **Fred C.** said he didn't hear any. **Mike K.** stated that he heard from a few people that they only got six laps. **Paula** said Robert talked to most of the people who was upset and he thinks they are okay.

**Mike W.** reported on the track survey he conducted

**Track Manager Contract**

**Panhard Motorsports**

Things are progressing, but not as quick as they wanted. They would like to have a 40,000sf building inside the track. Ted would like to also have a skid pad built and the building on the outside of the track.

**Fred Schmucker's Concerns**

**Ted** stated that we can handle Timing and Scoring without moving it. The turn six wall has been looked at. **Fred S. (speaking as Executive Steward)** said that section 8, page 66 of the GCR says that national events what he put in his letter has to done.

**Timing and Scoring** – Fred S. would like to see T&S moved to area next to the grid. **Ted** disagrees that the DA thinks it needs to be moved. We are currently making modifications to improve the view for tapers. **Fred C.** asked if we were producing accurate results. **Lindsay Fox** stated that we currently use the manual system to compare to the AMB results and make sure they agree. **Fred C.** would like for us to make changes and see if the changes satisfy Fred S. at the drivers school.

**Turn 6** – **Ted** reported that there is a section of the track with tires that has been beaten back. **Art** stated that he usually works turn six and that since they have put the turned

up sand there no cars have gone into the tires. **Ted** said that we will build the wall to the original height 150' back. There was more discussion on how the tires should be tied together.

**Fred S. (as Board member)** complimented Ted and the Board on accomplishing good stuff. He feels there isn't a better track and stated "it's been a great two years."

**Ted** thanked the Board members who were leaving, Fred Schmucker, John Ingram and Skippy Boatright.

Ted was voted back onto the Board as well as Fred Clark and Robert Frazier from the south. Judy Corbitt and Skippy Boatright had a tie and Skippy backed down to let Judy serve on the Board.
