## SARRC Best Race At Roebing

Drivers from throughout the Southeast joined together for great weather and exciting racing action to conclude the 2003 SARRC season at the annual SARRC Invitational Challenge (SIC).

Over 190 entrants raced on Roebing Road's 2.02 mile circuit October 4th and 5th. Many championships were decided at the event.

As usual the Spec Miata class was one of the strongest at the track. Joe Evans put on a good show as he took top honors at the SIC and for the Southeast Division for 2003. Buccaneer Region's Steve Lawrence took 18th overall.

The second race of the weekend were the IT7, ITA and ITS competitors. Kevin Busler was the highest finishing Buccaneer member taking 6th in ITS.

Third up to put on a show were the ITB, ITC, SSB and SSC competitors. Adam May took the

checked flag first, but after the decisions by the stewards it was David Wiegand who was awarded the top finishing position.

In SSB former Buccaneer Region RE Hyler Craft finished first. The SIC victory wasn't enough to clinch the SARRC championship, but Hyler did all that he could.

Group 4 was a diverse group of sports racers and open-wheel cars. John Zuccarelli took first in FA and first overall.

Up next was Group 5 where Brad Wimberly of the Buccaneer Region took first place in AS.

Group 6 was full of Buccaneer Champions. John Lacombe took top honors in FP and secured his SARRC championship. While Steve Desimone, Buccaneer Region, placed first on the track, Kevin Eves, also of the Buccaneer Region, clinched the

SARRC Championship in the Legends class. If that weren't enough, third in Legends was Pete Bogart, yet another Buccaneer member.

Group 7 had competitors in four different classes. They were CFF, FV, FF and F5. The Buccaneer Region was well represented in FV where Fred Clark was the top Region finisher in second. Russ Stalvey finished fourth, Patrick Chaffin finished sixth and Tom Morrissett finished ninth.

Last up were the Spec Racer Fords. Dorian Foyil held off C. Peter Pope and Bruce Williams to take first place.
