Keeping Score

OK, I don't have an event to talk about this time (gotta get the stuff in to Lindsay for the newsletter on time, doncha know?). I sure hope tax day was kind to you this year!

Track records... I was remiss in last month's column. While we were congratulating Phil Croyle on his new track record in T1 from the Tom Nehl race, I completely overlooked a new track record in DSR by Travis Duder. He set the

new DSR record of 1:09.531 on lap seven, then broke on lap eleven. I don't usually look at the bottom of the results sheets for new lap records!

I haven't mentioned mylaps.com much - point your web browser at buccaneer.mylaps.com and enjoy the race results! But there's more! Register your transponder number with mylaps (it's free and they don't spam you) and you can get your own lap times.

Neat huh? But wait, there's more! (Now how much would you pay? It's still free!) You can select one of your competitors and the Website will give you a lap-by-lap breakdown of your times versus theirs. Each lap has a whizzy green/red indicator that shows if you did better than them and vice versa. I try to make sure that results are posted during the week after the event and that they actually match the official race results. (You'll note that the Buccaneer

Website always marks the mylaps results "Provisional".)

Matching the official race results can sometimes be tricky. Applying penalties per the GCR is a bit of an art form in terms of adjusting lap times for the car in question, but it can be done. On the next page are the track records. Take a look and either A) get an idea of how high they have to aim or B) marvel at the performance of the true immortals!
